Larger Church Update

With the recommendation of the Leadership Team of Chestnut Grove church, the members of the church voted on joining the Global Methodist Church following worship Sunday, **April 16**. The results of the vote were to pursue connection as a congregation within the Global Methodist Church as of July 1. I firmly believe that the Lord has guided us through this journey every step along this long process that we have been walking through and that He will continue to lead and guide us as we go forward together. I also believe that the GMC is a beautiful expression of faithful historical Christianity and also what I believe to be biblically sound Methodist emphasis. The final approval vote for us and the other 120-150 churches departing the Susquehanna Conference is scheduled for Wednesday, May 17. I invite your prayers for every church represented on this May 17 gathering in Williamsport, PA.

Disaffiliation Cost Update

The total costs were a little over \$174,000, and after some special offerings, we are now at approximately \$142,000 yet to be paid on the Loan(s). There will be a special offering this coming Sunday, **April 30**, designated to this cause (instead of giving to our 2nd Mile Missions for the month); thank you to everybody who has given and continue to give towards this debt. Our goal (1st target) is to get under \$100,000 by the end of 2023.

Bible Study



May Bible Book of the Month - Ezekiel



Our featured Bible book for this month of May is the book by the prophet Ezekiel. Ezekiel was taken from the Promised Land to Babylon (along with 8,000 other citizens of Jerusalem in 598 BC (2 Kings 24:10-17) and his call to be a prophet came 5 years later. He received his call at the age of 30, which would have been the same year that he would have began serving

as a priest, if he was still living in Jerusalem (for he was of priestly lineage).

Like Jeremiah, Ezekiel called for the people of Israel to repent of their sins and to submit to the Babylonians. The core themes of the book center on the critical event of the fall of Jerusalem in 586 BC. After focusing on the impending judgment of God in the earlier chapters of the book, the focus moves more towards the bright and beautiful future that God still had planned for His people. This book is a clear reminder that even in the worst circumstances, the Lord does not give up on His good plans and promises for humanity.

While there are different theories as to the structure of this important book of the Bible, Dr. David A. Dorsey proposes that the book consists of 7 units and within each unit there are 7 sections (see handout in the lobby). This suggests that this book was put together with much care, as 7 is a common biblical number representing fullness or completion. May God bless your reading this month!

For the month of <u>June</u> we will be in the books of **Philippians, Colossians, and Philemon**.

Sermon Series



I am excited to share with you a new sermon series that I'm planning to begin **May 7** on the Minor Prophets. The Minor Prophets are the 12 smaller prophetic books found in the Old Testament. Although they are smaller in size, the messages that are conveyed are truly far from being of minor importance.

There is so much value in studying the prophetic writings of Scripture. Jesus draws a parallel between his followers and the biblical prophets when he said during the Sermon on the Mount, "Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you, and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same


way they persecuted the prophets who were before you." So studying the prophets should be right up our ally as Christians today.


Our book study for Monday, **May 8**, will be "<u>D.L. Moody</u>" (by Faith Coxe Bailey). D. L. Moody's reaction was quick and to the point. "No! A thousand times no! I have no intentions of standing off here in New York City and approving something I know so little about. But I'll think it over, Emeline. Then one of these days, I'll come out to Chicago and we can talk some more about it."



Moody's initial reaction to that "something" was to change through God's leading. That "something" is now the world-renowned Moody Bible Institute,

which trains hundreds of men and women each year to understand and use the Scriptures.

D. L. Moody dared to take up a challenge and see what God could do with a life totally committed to Him. Here is the story of the greatest American evangelist of the 1800's and the founder of the Moody Bible Institute.



Our book study for **September 11** will be "<u>A Woman of Words</u>" (By Angela Hunt). Disciple Matthew, a former tax collector, is invited to work with Peter, James, and John in Jerusalem. He dreams of preaching and performing miracles like his fellow apostles, but he finds his dreams postponed because of a request from Yeshua's mother. Well aware of the passing years, Mary asks Matthew to help her record the stories of Yeshua while the eyewitnesses are still alive. Reluctantly, he agrees, though the longer he and Mary work together, the more difficult their task

becomes. Not only are they pressured by opposition from friends and foes alike, but Gaius Caesar, better known as Caligula, is determined to raise a statue of himself in the Holy Temple, even if it means killing every man in Israel. As Matthew works to save his people, Mary encourages him to come to terms with issues from his past. When they finally near the completion of their project, Matthew realizes that the job he reluctantly accepted might be his God-given destiny.


