
Sermon Series - Philippians



I am happy to share with you that a new sermon series on the Book of Philippians is coming soon! This epistle of the Apostle Paul is incredibly powerful and filled with excellent instruction for God's church today. I look forward to unpacking this beautiful letter with all of you beginning in August.

July - Bible Book of the Month - Daniel

As we turn the page into the month of July together, I would like to first remind you that our Bible books of the month are always invitations and not requirements. If you sense the Lord is leading you to read and meditate on other Scriptures, please do not feel obligated to read the Bible Book of the Month. I simply offer the book of the month as one means by which the Holy Spirit can be used to guide your time in God's written Word.



I am excited to announce that our highlighted book of the Bible for the month of <u>July is the Book of Daniel</u>. Daniel is both one of the easiest as well as most difficult books in the entire Bible to read and understand. The first half of the book (chapters 1-6) is filled with vivid and familiar stories of the faithfulness of Daniel and his friends, as they remained loyal and committed to God in the midst of the conquest of Judah by the Babylonians. These stories powerfully reveal God's sovereignty over all nations and rulers. Each of these stories are reminders that God is ruler over all and He is worthy for the complete trust of His people. This reminds us that no matter the cost of following Jesus Christ today, it is more than worth it. May we find courage and strength in our Christian living as we read these chapters of Daniel.

The second half of Daniel (chapters 7-12) consists of more complicated dreams and visions from God giving to Daniel. While these chapters are more difficult to comprehend, I would like to turn your attention to two things in particular. First, In Daniel 7:13-14, Daniel receives a clear message from the Lord that would come a human being that will one day be worshipped by people from every nation. THIS IS A VERY CLEAR PROPHECY THAT WAS FULFILLED IN JESUS CHRIST. JESUS IS THE SON OF MAN FROM THIS VISION WHOM THE ANCIENT OF GOD (GOD THE FATHER) WILL CELEBRATE BEING WORSHIPPED ALONGSIDE HIM. This is one of the many Old Testament passages that reveals God's unfolding redemption plan for humanity.

Second, even though there are many confusing images that may seem unclear to us, as the handout (from Dr. David A. Dorsey) will show, God is in the details. The Lord knew in advance detail after detail about various rulers and events that would come to pass. May the handout on the fulfillment on various things mentioned in Daniel 11 strengthen your faith to trust God in the details of your life. May the Lord bless you as you spend time with Him in His Word this month.

<u>August's</u> Bible Book of the Month will be **Song of Songs**. <u>September's</u> Bible Book of the Month will be **Hebrews**.

The Chosen - Season 3



If you missed any of the episodes during May and June when the Bible Study group watched it, you can join us at any of the above dates to see what you missed.




Vacation Bible School

<u>Prayers For Travelers</u>



As Matthew works to save his people, Mary encourages him to come to terms with issues from his past. 
