I would like to remind you that our Bible books of the month are always invitations and not requirements. If you sense the Lord is leading you to read and meditate on other Scriptures, please do not feel obligated to read the Bible Book of the Month. I simply offer the book of the month as one means by which the Holy Spirit can be used to guide your time in God's written Word.

Bible scholar Leon Morris wrote, "Romans is not an easy book. But it has always yielded rich dividends to anyone who has taken the time to study it seriously, and it does so still."

In this month of Thanksgiving, we can thank God for the profound gift that is

Paul's letter to the Church in Rome. This letter is filled with important truths as Paul explains the good news of Jesus to a lost and broken world. God's sweeping plan is unpacked and explained in great depth in this epistle and it should lead its readers to stand in awe of God's loving plan for them.

At the heart of the letter is how God offers humanity righteousness or right-standing before Him by God's grace through individuals putting their faith in Jesus Christ. Without God's mercy, all of humanity stands guilty and justly condemned by God, but out of God's deep love for us, Jesus was offered as a sinsubstitute for our sins. It was love that led and compelled Jesus, the God-Man, to offer up Himself on our behalf as a sin-offering.

While this letter is very profound and deep on many points, there is also a sweet simplicity to it as well. Jesus laid down His life so that all people (Jew and Gentile) might find true life in and through Him (chapters 1-11). And all the church (made up of Jews and Gentiles) are to humbly live out their lives as believers in ways that demonstrate growth in Christ likeness and in joyful service to one another (chapters 12-16). Lord's blessings in reading and meditating on this beautiful epistle.

Congregational Turkey Dinner - November 5


Our annual turkey dinner will be Sunday, **November 5**, after our All Saints Day worship service. Carol Clayton has worked hard along with her other kitchen

Chestnut Grove's Book Club is now holding their book gathering discussions at the <u>Dillsburg Library from</u> 10:15AM-11:30AM.



Our book study for <u>January 8</u>, 2024 will be "<u>When Jesus Wept"</u> (by Bodie and Brock Thoene). Set against the political and religious turmoil of the times, the Thoenes' story vividly reimagines the evolving friendship between Jesus and Lazarus." --Publishers Weekly.

- You will now see the list of all the courses available to us. Copy and paste the link of the course you are interested in into a new tab and press enter.
- Information about the course will open. When you are ready to enroll, click the "Start Today" button. This will take you to the screen to complete the enrollment process (your payment method, etc) to finish enrollment. NOTE: If you have a promo code for the course you are taking, don't forget to enter it at this point (left side of this screen). Then complete your purchase.
